Reckon u should add a bass or something to fatten it up when it comes in after `let the bass kick`. Loved the quick stop-start breakdown thingy at roughly 2 minutes. Rest is ace `cept maybe too short.

LovelyGrowler: Sounds real good to me. Like the big distorted portamento-noise but i reckon it sounds out of place where it comes in, maybe need to bring it in at a breakdown or something. Just my oppinion tho..

LastPrt2: Nice beat. Some prodigy influence in some of ur work at all? Think the bass-synth procession is a little bare though.. needs something to bring it all together?
